



Frequently Asked Question's

Check in and out procedures:

What time can you check in and out of accommodation? You are able to check in from 4pm to all accommodation and we ask that you check out by 10am. If you are camping we don't have a set check in time. We can accept late check ins post 11pm by arrangement.

When is reception/shop open? The reception and shop is manned from 7am till 8pm daily.

Do you accept walk in bookings? Yes we will always try and accommodate walk-in bookings but we always suggest that you book ahead to avoid any disappointment especially over peak times April - September.

Group Bookings? Yes we accept group bookings and can try to have you situated next to each other however we dont accept stag or hen parties.

Bar/Restaurant:

What are opening and closing times? The restaurant is open from 7am and serves breakfast and food throughout the day. You don't need to book a table just pop in when you are ready, if you are looking for a large table to be seated together then you can arrange this with the bar staff in advance to avoid disappointment. The bar closes at 11pm, we have lots of local beers and ciders on tap so make sure you enjoy them responsibly.

Camping:

We have 90 pitches and we are open to any size of tents at present, in 2025 you will need to book the size of pitch that you need. We can allocate pitches next to friends and family so please let us know at the time of booking.

Do you accept dogs? Yes we are fully dog friendly, please make sure your dog is on the lead at all times and that you pick up after them and dispose of waste in the bins provided.

Do you allow BBQ/Campfires? We allow BBQ's or small camp fires as long as they are raised of the grass and in a raised safe container.

We ask that you respect your neighbours in our camping area and throughout the park so noise to be minimum after 11pm.



Pods:

How many can your pods sleep? Our pods sleep 4 adults and we accept well behaved dogs also.

What facilities are available in the pods? Our pods are basic with a plug socket for phone chargers. We ask that you either supply your own bedding and towels or you can hire these from the site. You are able to have a BBQ at your pod outside on the gravel in a safe raised container, you must not put the BBQ on the decking. You are able to park 1 car next to the pod.

En-Suite Rooms:

We have a mixture of twin and triple en-suite rooms, we accept well behaved dogs but there is a supplement charge for this. All bedding and towels are included in your room and we have tea/coffee facilities in the room also.

Are you able to park next to your room? No cars will need to be parked in the designated car park for your stay.

Are there TV's in the room? We don't have TV's in the room, wifi is available in the rooms however signal is intermittent due to our location.

Bell Tents:

Our beautiful bell tents are located a short walk from reception where you will find the toilet and shower facilities. We can accommodate group bookings but please let the reception team know at the time of booking.

What is included? Bedding and towels are included with your bell tent, they are also dog friendly. You are able to have a BBQ outside on the raised platform provided.

Motorhomes pitches:

We have 10 hardstanding and 3 grass pitches, we do not have hook up facilities on any pitches and we strongly suggest that you book ahead as they fill up fast. We can take motorhomes up to 3.5m long, please note we have a tight corner turning into the campsite and a narrow bridge.

Do you accept tent boxes? Yes we accept tent boxes and must be booked under a motorhome pitch.

Do you accept awnings? Yes we accept awnings as long as they are contained in the size of your pitch.



General Questions:

Do you have recycling facilities? Yes we have full recycling facilities available and encourage you to recycle as much as you can.

WIFI - we have wifi available on site but due to the sites location signal does vary in strength and coverage on the site.

Do you have drying facilities? We have drying facilities at the park, if you ask at the shop during opening hours they will access this for you

Cost to hire of towels and bedding? Towels are £5 per person and a sleeping bag is £10 per person to hire.
